#### THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

#### PREAMBLE

WE THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation:

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

#### THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

#### Chapter IV A

#### FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

#### ARTICLE 51 A

Fundamental Duties - It shall be the duty of every citizen of India -

- To abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- To cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- To uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India.
- To defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- To promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religions, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities, to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of woman;
- To value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- To protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- To develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- To safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- To strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

### TO THE STUDENTS

Dear Children.

Bring this diary to the class daily without fail. If you properly use the diary, it will help you to be systematic and regular in your studies. The aim of providing diary is to help you in forming the habit of doing planned work and study regularly.

You are gifted with hearing, sight, all other body parts including a normal brain. You live with your near and dear ones. You get food and clothes as per need. How lucky you are children. There are innumerable children who are deprived of all these basic needs. So be thankful to God. You are given an opportunity to get knowledge, learn good things and make a bright future. Make use of this opportunity.

Every one of you have enormous potential to reach the pinnacle of success. What you need is only to know your potential and work hard. You should feel that you can win and just try. You will win. Then remember, substitute for hardwork is only hardwork.

May God bless you all.

#### Dear parent,

The advent of new session rings in new aspirations. I take this opportunity to appraise you of certain information deemed essential.

- Ensure that your child reaches in time and in proper uniform everyday. Late comers and students in improper uniform are not permitted inside the vidyalaya after 8.30 a.m. and disciplinary action might be taken against them.
- Children are strictly forbidden to leave school on any ground between 8.30 a.m. to 2.40 p.m. No short leave or half day leave will be sanctioned.
- Do not send the child to school if she/he is not well. Send leave application.
- Encourage your ward to read English news papers and hear English news daily. Ask him/her to write two pages daily (copying from newspaper or text book or self writing)
- Carry out surprise checking of bags of your ward.

Parents are requested to monitor the progress of their wards and meet the concerned teachers for suggestions in order to improve their performance. Parents can meet the teachers on the last working day of every month between 12 noon and 1.p.m.

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- Create awareness in the children regarding the danger of alcoholism, drug abuse and immoral behaviour of stealing.
- See the student diary daily. It is necessary to bring the diary to school everyday.
- Inform the class teacher if there is any change of address or telephone number.
- Visit of parents/outsiders to the vidyalaya for official work is strictly from 2 pm to 2.40 pm.
- Parents are welcome to meet the principal (teachers if any special reason) between 2.30 pm to 3 pm for constructive suggestions and complaints if any.
- Admissions will be done only on Wednesday and Fridays.
- Encourage the student to talk to the teachers, H.M., V.P or Principal
  if she/he feels any kind of problem in the school.
- Parents should meet the class teachers and subject teacher on the last working day of the month between 12 noon and 1 pm to know about the performance and behaviour of your ward in the school.
- Ensure that the personal record page is filled and contact number is given to use in case of emergency.
- Date of birth and other details of the student are certified strictly as per the documents submitted at the time of admission only.
- Students are not permitted to wear gold ornaments in the vidyalaya. They are also not permitted to bring costly items like mobile phones, and carry money unnecessarily.
- Ensure that they take proper breakfast and carry enough food to eat during tiffin break.
- Do not shift your duty to tuition teacher. Ask your child about his/her activities in school everyday. Ensure that she/he learns the lessons taught in the class daily.
- See that the children had proper haircut, nail cut etc.
- As per CBSE guidelines the behavior of the child is observed and recorded which will be reflected in the report card.
- Attitude towards teachers and peer group are also assessed.
- Encourage the children to participate in non-scholastic subjects. Grooming a child is a joint venture of both parents and teachers. Your child is our most valuable possession. Let us join hands and give our children a schooling they will always cherish. We solicit your co-operation for the better functioning of the vidyalaya.

Single Girl child has fee exemption from class VI to XII for which a fresh affidavit has to be submitted in Rs. 50/- stamp paper.

#### Admission / Re-admission Fee:

An Admission Fee of Rs. 25/- shall be paid at the time of fresh admission to the school.

An Admission Fee of Rs. 25/- is also charged on transfer from other Kendriya Vidyalaya. Re-Admission Fee Rs. 100/- for names struck off due to any reason.

#### Mode of Payment:

Fee payment may be done quarterly by the 15 of April / July / October / January. Pay the fees at any branch of Union Bank of India or pay the fees online at the portal at http://eremit.unionbankofindia.co.in/kvfees/using internet banking/debit card/credit card/mobile banking.

\* However old fees structure is followed as per court order till further orders.

#### Fine:

A fine of Rs. 5/- per day for VVN and Rs. 5/- per day for tuition fee will be charged up to the last working day. If the fees is not paid by 15 April / July / October / January, the name of the student shall be struck off from the roll due to non-payment of dues & Re-admission will be done only on payment of Rs. 100/- along with the late payment fine.

For classes IX to XII in respect of the students who are required to deposit the fees in addition to VVN, in case of late deposit of tuition fees & VVN fees, a fine / higher contribution is to be charged separately @ 5/- per day. If both the tuition fees & VVN are deposited late, the late fees fine & higher contribution will be Rs. 10/- per day.

The name of the student will be restored only after charging late fine by way of tuition fees & VVN + Re-Admission Fees.

#### **EXEMPTIONS**

Exemptions from paying the tuition fees will be granted only to the following category students:-

- 1. Girls are exempted from Tuition Fees.
- 2. SC / ST students, on production of valid S.C / ST Certificate.
- 3. Sons / Daughters of Kendriya Vidyalaya Employees.
- 4. If more than one child of the same parent are studying in classes IX to XII child in higher classes will pay full tuition fee & the other only half.
- 5. Poverty cum merit fee concession may also be granted by the principal to deserving students on submission of written application from the parents supported with documentary evidence. This is subject to the available quota.
- No exemption is granted in VVN in any class for any reason for any category they belong to except single girl from class VI onwards.
- 7. Students admitted under RTE quota are exempted from all fees.
- \* Exemptions will not be allowed to the children of Govt. Employees getting reimbursement from their departments.
